

Ground Covers—Sun Lovers

Vinca minor - Periwinkle

Great ground cover for all locations, even the deepest shade! In spring and early summer numerous purple flowers add to the beauty of this plant.

Growing Requirements—full sun to deep shade.

Planting—3” tall, 18”-24” wide. Covers large areas quickly.

Care—Prefers moist soil. Tolerates extreme heat.

Pests/Disease—deer resistant. No serious diseases.

Dividing/Propagating— divide in spring or fall

Houttuynia cordata—Chameleon Flower

A great performer in sun or shade. The more sun it gets, the brighter the variegation of pink, yellow and green leaves. Small white summer flowers.

Growing Requirements—Moist to wet soil in sun or partial shade. Can thrive in standing water.

Planting—6”to 9” tall mound; spreads by rhizomes

Care—Can be invasive. Plant away from choice perennials.

Pests/Disease—Deer resistant. No serious diseases.

Dividing/Propagating—divide in spring or fall or by cuttings in the summer
