

Polygonatum biflorum -- Solomon's Seal

Light up the shady areas of your garden with this plant! Small greenish white flowers hang down from arching stems in May. The flowers give way to blue berries later in summer and the foliage turns gold in fall.

Growing Requirements

Tolerates full sun to full shade with moist, rich soil.

Planting

Height 12-36 inches, spread 12-18 inches. Plants spread slowly by rhizomes and form clumps. Pair with shade garden plants, like Brunnera (Siberian Bugloss), Cranesbill Geranium, Dicentra (Bleeding Heart), Epimedium (Barrenwort), Ferns, Hellebore, Heuchera (Coral Bells) and Tiarella (Foamflower).

Care

A very easy care plant that will reward you with many years of charming flowers in the spring garden. No deadheading required.

Pests/Diseases

Rarely bothered by disease. If the weather is extremely damp, you may see signs of powdery mildew or another fungal disease.

Dividing /Propagating

Divide in early spring or fall and leave several buds on each division for the best success.
